RULES AND REGULATIONS: Please read thoroughly.

1. This competition is open to all Malaysian or Foreigner who stay in Malaysia.

Entry Fee is RM100 per tank and refundable upon turn up during the bench-in day (17th Sep 2015).

- 2. This is an Aquascaping [Aquatic Plants Layout] Competition, tank size is conventional/standard sized tanks only. We will not accept odd shaped (round, bow front, bowl etc) or tanks with depth or width that is more than the length of the tank. Rounded edge tanks without joints are allowed. Size-not longer than 24"/60cm and not smaller than 12"/30cm [+/- 2.5cm]. We prefer a standard size tank that is rectangular, rounded corners are acceptable but not overt distortion and bow front tanks. Please call us at 019-577 9888 to ask if unsure.
- 3. Any style of Aquascaping like Nature, Dutch or Modern is permitted. Toys, plastic decorative items or any other items that are deemed unnatural/gimmicky will be subject to marks deduction.
- 4. Participants are to provide their own tanks, plants, fishes or freshwater fauna, lighting, CO2 diffusing system, water filters, plug extensions and any other forms of accessories. Natural decorative items like stones, rocks, sand, soil and driftwood are permitted. Participants are advised to minimise or hide the accessories in the tank for judging aesthetics.
- 5. The main organisers will be providing stands for the tanks and 3 plug points per tank, water and some trolleys to help transport your tank to the main competition area. Participants are advised to bring their own pails, siphon hoses, anti-chlorine, nets and other useful equipment.
- 6. All participants are to ensure that all tanks submitted together with relevant equipment are in good working order, defects would have to be noted and acknowledged before and after the bench in. Whilst reasonable care will

be taken by the organisers and the organising committee members to ensure that no damage will occur to tanks and equipment of participants, the organisers and Aquatic Creation Technologies Sdn. Bhd. (ACT) will not be held liable for any breakage, damage or faults whatsoever during the course of the competition. Any damage or death of fauna that may occur during the course of the competition must be reported to any of the ACT organising committee immediately.

- 7. All participants are permitted to perform minor touch-ups or adjustments to their work during bench in. Participants are advised to use their mature filter to ensure clear water for judging as there is little time between bench-in and judging. We will allocate a little time for minor touch up before the judging begins as we understand there will be unforeseen circumstances that might affect the judges' impression.
- 8. Judges and the ACT organising committee have the exclusive right to disqualify any entry that is deemed to contravene the Rules and Regulations of the competition, whether stated or implied. The ACT organising committee reserves the right to disallow any participant from entering the competition for whatever the reason if deemed necessary. Any submissions that does not meet the criteria of a planted tank, whether in size or decorations, as stated in the Rules and Regulations will be disqualified at the discretion of the competition judges or the ACT organising committee. Judges' decision is final. If you have any doubts, please ask any ACT officer on duty during bench in to avoid disqualification.
- 9. ACT organising committee reserves the right to make amendments to the Rules and Regulations as may be necessary during the course of the competition.
- 10. All participants are to attend the benching-in as stated above at The Mines International Convention Centre. Late entries will not be entertained as The Mines International Exhibition Centre has strict closing hours.
- 11. The organisers and the ACT committee reserve the right to make changes to the winners' prizes as may be required due to whatever the circumstances. Participants with more than one entry can win only one prize.
- 12. All winners will be notified through their contact number provided and will be required to attend the prize giving ceremony. All winners will be notified by phone.
